Fitting liability

It is the customer's responsibility to install the child restraint in the vehicle. Branch staff are not certified to fit them or advise on how they should be fitted.

Australian legislation


By law, all children up to seven years of age must be secured in the correct child car restraint according to their size and age. A child may stop using a child restraint once they turn seven or if their seated shoulder height is above the top mark of the restraint or their eye level is above the back of the booster seat. A child under seven cannot sit in the front row of a vehicle that has more than one row of seats.

Seat compliance

Overseas child restraints cannot be used in Australia because they do not comply with Australian Standards and do not display an Australian Standards logo.
